Weather forecast summary:

As per the forecast issued by India Meteorological Department, the sky will remain partly cloudy with dry weather likely to be expected during next 5 days. The maximum temperature may range between 28 to 31 °C and minimum temperature may range between 12 to 14 °C for next five days. Relative humidity may range between 40 to 70%. Wind may blow mainly in the North North Eastern (NNE) direction with the average speed of 1 km/hour.

General Advisory:

- Hot and dry weather likely to be expected during next five days.
- As per Extended Range Forecast System (ERFS), rainfall below normal, maximum temperature is likely to be above normal and minimum temperature is likely to be below normal over Jammu & Kashmir between 22.05.2024 and 26.05.2024 in the UT of Jammu and Kashmir.

SMS Advisory: Due to prevailing dry and hot weather conditions, farmers are advised to apply light & frequent irrigation in all vegetable crops and fruit plants (especially young plants) in the morning or in the evening hours to avoid moisture stress.

Apiculture		Care /Feed supplement	 Keeping in view the present weather conditions, farmers are advised to shift the honey bee colonies towards shady conditions or place them under open straw huts. Bees need water to dilute honey and to cool the hives during hot weather conditions. Farmers are advised to keep water trough filled with coarse gravel near the hive. It helps bees to spend more time in collecting nectar and less time for water collection. Provide proper ventilation by slightly raising the brood chamber. Make sure that bees do not pass through the ventilation otherwise robbing may be induced. For protection of ants put the legs of apiary into water so that ants could not attack apiary.
